## Rubbish & Recycling Proposal

The Kerikeri Cruising Club currently provides both rubbish & recycling services for the purpose of disposal of boating waste. The facility has open unsecured access & there is evidence that it is being abused by people who are not club members & even some club members dumping domestic waste & taking advantage of the services paid for by marina licensees & the Club.

The Club would like your input before undertaking further work on the rubbish & recycling services. There will be an opportunity for discussion at both the Marina Berth Licence Holders AGM & the Club AGM. You are also invited to give written input. The deadline for written input is Wednesday 3 October 2018.

After the AGMs, a decision will be made about whether to pursue changing the rubbish services & Club members will be kept advised.

Three options are being considered. These are:

- 1. Status Quo year-round rubbish & recycling service with unsecured access
- 2. Limited Seasonal Service December-February rubbish & recycling service with unsecured access. Pre-paid rubbish bags available for purchase from the office outside the peak season or take waste home.
- 3. No Rubbish or Recycling Facilities boating waste to be removed from site by boat owners & marina users. Pre-paid rubbish bags available for purchase from the office or take waste home.
