4 Health & Safety

COVID Level 2 requirements underway particularly for the clubhouse

Clubhouse open under Level 2

The clubhouse has been open under COVID Alert Level 2 providing table service & a designated server by utilising volunteer club members. This system was in place for 4 weeks. However, the numbers of diners & required number of volunteers (some of whom need to be skilled & experienced) means this volunteer staffing is not sustainable for the longer term.

A revised system was trialled for the weekend of 11th & 13th September. The new system saw one customer from each table designated as the 'server', this person will be responsible for taking orders to & from the bar & kitchen. An additional paid staff person will be available on the restaurant floor to educate the diners & assist with tables that require help e.g. large tables or tables where self-service is challenging. The additional paid staff will work during the service peak approximately from 5-7pm.

The numbers in the clubhouse are increasing as is the turnover. This is expected as the spring & summer season begins but the overall diner numbers are significantly better than last year.

Keelboat prize givings (after races) are a challenge in terms of compliance with the Level 2 conditions i.e. sitting down, table service, contact tracing compliance, groups of less than 10. Suggest keelboat prize givings be reviewed prior to the start of the summer racing season & an alternative Level 2 plan be developed for these.

Many thanks to volunteers for helping in the clubhouse under Level 2 up to this point.

5.1 Clubhouse

The clubhouse was reopened on Friday 3 July after the COVID 19 Lockdown. Concern about the financial viability of the clubhouse restaurant & bar over the winter months (June-August) when historically turnover is low, prompted a proposal from the Treasurer to open the clubhouse while implementing cost, labour & price reviews to improve the financials.

The Clubhouse has been open for a little over 2 months. A comparison of the figures for this period compared with figures from the winter of 2019 is below.
