4.1 Mooring Lines & Set-up

Mandatory springs on the breakwater moored vessels

Independent shackles for pile ring springs

D-rings on plates with 5 bolts & aligned with angle of mooring lines. P Donahoe will get prices.

It was resolved that the installation of spring lines be compulsory for boats moored on the breakwater with 30 June 2014 the deadline for installation. Proposed P Harris/Seconded M Carere: Carried

Communication to all marina users re the issue will indicate that compulsory springs may be expanded to include all boats within the marina.
