Keelboat Racing Covid-19 Level 2 Safety Requirements – Notice to Competitors

These requirements are to be read in conjunction with the Sailing Instructions and are considered a condition of entry to any KCC keelboat race. Where these rules conflict with the NOR or Sailing Instructions, this notice will override those instructions

Entries

- The start-box will not be open to take entries
- Where possible, entries should be made online in advance of the race. You can make entries here: <https://forms.gle/CmTyFWgb6cvdVnur8> or by scanning the QR code:



- Paper entries may be made on the entry form outside the start box. Bring your own pen.
- One entry form per boat please
- Entries must include all crew names, first and last, including the skipper, and phone numbers for each crew member. VHF entries will not be accepted due to this requirement
- Crews may not be more than 10 people including the skipper
- Entry fees should be paid by electronic transfer to KCC account number **02 0352 0012451 00**
 - Use Keelboat as the reference, and your boat name as the code and the date as the reference.
 - Boats will not be disqualified if payments have not cleared prior to the race.
 - Consider a series entry rather than race by race

Hygiene Requirements

- The skipper is to ensure that all crew understand the information regarding precautions for managing Covid-19 and keeping themselves safe, for example hand washing, coughing into elbows, physical distancing of 1m where people know each other, 2m where they do not
- Boat and shared equipment to be washed extensively prior to and post sailing
- Where equipment is unable to be sanitised, for example ropes, a withholding period could be considered to allow any virus particles on these surfaces to die, e.g. 120 hours between uses.
- All boats are to have hand sanitiser available for crew use
- Do not share food or beverages
- Follow good hand washing hygiene protocols –sanitisers, hand washing and drying
- Crews should consider wearing sailing gaiters, sunglasses and full-fingered gloves
- Any person who shows flu-like symptoms should not be on a boat.

Results

- Finishing times should be text to Daniel – 021471553 including the boat name and finishing time in the format HH:MM:SS within one hour of the last boat finishing
- Results will be posted online on the KCC Website
- Race prize giving will not be held until further notice
