#### 1.0 Rules

- 1.1 The race will be governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing* 2013-2016.
- 1.2 The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part II, Category 5 shall apply to keel yachts and multihulls.
- 1.3 The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part V, Category C shall apply for trailer yachts.
- 1.4 The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part VI, Category B shall apply for sportboats.
- 1.5 The Elliott 5.9 Association Class Rules shall apply.
- 1.7 The Flying Fifteen Association Class Rules shall apply.
- 1.8 The required safety gear must be carried on board at all times and may be inspected.

# 2.0 Changes to the Racing Rules

The Rules will be modified in accordance with Rule 86 Changes to the racing rules, as follows:-

- 2.1 For any protests where only a rule of Part 2 is alleged to have been broken, an arbitration hearing will be offered prior to any formal hearing. YNZ regulations part 4.5.5 applies.
- 2.2 Rule 44.1 *Taking a Penalty* is changed so that the 720° turn is replaced by a 360° turn.
- 2.3 Rules 51 Setting and Sheeting Sails and 52 Manual Power are modified to allow nominated boats i.e. [A Canting Keel], [Water Ballast Tanks] with movable Ballast to compete. Boats must comply with ISAF Appendix K [www.sailing.org] and Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations clause 6 [www.yachtingnz.org.nz]. TCFs may be altered accordingly.

### 3.0 Eligibility and Entry

- 3.1 A and B Division The regatta is open to all: Keelboats, Multihulls, Open Keel Yachts, Sports Boats, Trailer Yachts, Sports Trailer Yachts.
- 3.2 C Division Traditional yachts defined as any construction, designed before 1960. No spinnakers. Open to all, Club members or not.
- 3.3 Individual race entries will be accepted prior to the KCC five minute signal of that entries Division, entry is available on the entry sheet in the start box. An entry fee of \$5.00 per Handicap system applies.
- 3.4 Individual race entries will be accepted by VHF or phone (407 9434) prior to the KCC five minute signal of that entries Division.

#### 8.0 Prizes

- 8.1 Prize giving will be held no sooner than 1 hour after the last yacht has crossed the finish line.
- 8.2 Visiting Yacht entries are eligible for Race Prizes
- 8.3 Visiting Yacht entries are not eligible for Club Trophies.
- 8.4 Fastest Time Trophy is available to A Division competitors only.
- 8.4 The following prizes shall be awarded:
  - Rum for the winner of each division.
