## NOTICE OF RACE.

### 1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules Of Sailing 2013-2016*.
- 1.2 The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part 1 shall apply.
- 1.3 All boats must comply with their Class Rules.

### 2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all YNZ recognized centreboard classes.
- 2.2 Competitors must be members of a yacht club affiliated to Yachting New Zealand.
- 2.3 Entry fee for the day is \$15 per competitor in single handed boats or \$10 in two handed and where there are two or more sailors in a family.

### 3 SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

- 3.1 Sunday June 1<sup>st</sup>.
  - 0830 Registration
  - 0915 Briefing
  - 1000 Warning signal for first race.
- 3.2 Four races are scheduled and will be sailed back to back.

### 4 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 4.1 Sailing instructions will be available at registration.

### 5 RACING AREA

- 5.1 The races will be held in the Kerikeri Inlet.

## 6 COURSES TO BE SAILED

- 6.1 The courses will be trapezoidal for all classes except for A Class which will be windward/leeward.
- 6.2 Except when starting or finishing, boats shall not pass through the start/finish line while a race is in progress.

## 7 SCORING

- 7.1 Three entries in any class are required to constitute a fleet.
- 7.2 No scores will be excluded.
- 7.3 Boats will be scored for their place in their own class, not in the fleet in which they have started.
- 7.4 In addition to class scores, boats starting in mixed fleets will be scored on a handicap basis.

## 8 PRIZEGIVING

- 8.1 Prizes will be awarded to the first three places in each Class.
- 8.2 Handicap prizes will be awarded to the top three boats in each fleet.
- 8.3 The prizes will be presented as soon as possible after completion of the last race.

## 9 KEELBOAT RUM RACES

- 9.1 Racing will be concluded in time for centreboard sailors to crew on keelboats competing in Club Rum Races.

## 10 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- 10.1 Competitors compete in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. The Organising Authority and all persons involved in the regatta will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, or after the regatta.
