NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part 1 shall apply.
- 1.3 All boats sailing in a class must comply with their Class Rules.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all Yachting New Zealand recognized centreboard classes.
- 2.2 Competitors must be members of a yacht club affiliated to Yachting New Zealand.
- 2.3 Entry fee per day is \$10 per competitor in single handed boats or \$5 for two handed and where there are two or more sailors in a family.

3 SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

- 3.1 Each Sunday 1000hrs Registration
 - 1100hrs Briefing

1200hrs Warning signal for race 1 with four races back to back.

3.2 No warning signal will be made after 1500hrs.

4 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 Sailing instructions will be available at registration.

5 RACING AREA

5.1 The races will be sailed in Kerikeri Inlet or Te Puna Inlet.

6 COURSES TO BE SAILED

- 6.1 The courses will be trapezoidal for all classes.
- 6.2 Except when starting or finishing, boats shall not pass through the start/ finish line while a race is in progress.

7 SCORING

- 7.1 Three entries in each class are required to constitute a fleet.
- 7.2 Boats will be scored for their place in their own class, not in the fleet in which they have started.
- 7.3 No score will be excluded until five races have been completed. A boat's worst score will be excluded when five or more races have been completed.
- 7.4 In addition to class scores, boats starting in mixed fleets will be scored on a handicap basis. In this case 7.2 does not apply.

8 PRIZE GIVING

- 8.1 Prizes will be awarded to the first three places within each class.
- 8.2 Handicap prizes will be presented to the top three boats in each fleet.
- 8.3 Prizes will be presented as soon as possible after completion of the last race on Sunday August 20th.
